EVENTING Rally Entry Form - AMPLIFICATION

TEAM CONTACT PERSON - Will receive emails concerning the rally. The contact person is expected to pass along all info to the team members and their parents/chaperones. The contact person will receive draft schedule, team lists, etc and are expected to verify all information on the team for accuracy

TEAM NAME: To avoid confusion when we have more than one team from a club, we ask that the teams select a Team Name. For Eventing Rally, please select an Australian animal as your team name.

COMPETITOR NAME: Nicknames are fine, but all paperwork, forms, and awards will use this name.

- Capt: One teammate must be designated as the captain. Does not need to be the oldest or highest rated member, but should be comfortable talking to Rally officials and conducting HM and score inquiries. The Stable Manager MAY be the captain or another rider please add "SM" after the name.
- SM: Stable Manager. Unmounted Stable Manager is not required, but it is highly recommended.
- Teams need three riders, but we can form scramble teams with incomplete teams and single competitors. Use this form for singles and incomplete teams.

PC AGE: The age on January 1, 2025

COMPETITION LEVEL: Enter on the of following: Pre-Elementary (18"), Elementary (2'), Intro/Starter (2'3" fixed), Beginner Novice (2'7" fixed, 3' brush), Novice (2'11"fixed, 3'7" brush), Training (3'3" fixed, 3'11" brush)

Teams may be formed with members of any Rating, Age, and Competition Level,

We will place Junior and Senior teams in separate divisions. Teams with ANY member 18 years old or over will be in the Senior Division. Teams with ALL members age 17 and under will be in the Junior Division.

QUALIFYING FOR CHAMPS 2026? Enter: NO, MODIFIED, or STANDARD

To qualify for Modified Division, competitors must be 10 years or older (no maximum age for Modified Division), be rated D2 EV or D2 HSE or over, and compete at Starter, Beginner Novice, Novice, or Training Level.

To qualify for Standard Division, competitors must be 12 years old or older, be rated C1 EV or C1 HSE or over, and compete at Starter, Beginner Novice, Novice, or Training Level.

In addition to this rally, qualifiers must complete one (for Beginner Novice or Novice) or two (for Training) USEA recognized event(s) at or above the competition level, both with numerical scores. For Standard Division, there must be no more than 20 XC jumping penalty points between ALL the competitions.

Stable Managers at championships must be a minimum of D2 HM for Modified and D3 HM for Standard.

VOLUNTEERS:

Coaches are allowed, but not mandatory. Teams may have more than one coach. Coaches may not be assigned other duties, including Chaperone.

Chaperones are required for teams that have ANY members that are under 18. Chaperones must remain onsite during the entire rally and can be assigned other duties. Chaperones may NOT also serve as coach.
